

## **Freshman and Sophomore Closed Campus Lunch**

Campus lunch is closed for freshman and sophomores. Students may purchase a lunch provided by Aramark, bring a lunch from home, or have a lunch delivered to the front school entrance at the designated lunch period. Arrangements for delivered lunches are to be done in advance and no time out of class or using cell phones is authorized to make lunch delivery arrangements. Staff will not have anything to do with delivered lunches.

*Due to excessive misuse of our policy to allow students to eat lunch with a family member on a special occasion, the policy has changed.*

Students may only leave the campus with an immediate family member, guardian or designated representative over 21 years of age for a special occasion only. The family member will call the office and request the student be allowed to leave campus with them for lunch, by sharing with the office staff what the special occasion is and the date of the request. On the requested special occasion date, the immediate family member or guardian will come into the office meeting the student and sign the student out of school. The student is expected to be back to school on time for their next class, unless a reasonable excuse exists and is approved by the administration. The administration reserves the right to deny the student from leaving closed campus due to academics, disciplinary or truancy issues, or the overuse of the special day occasions by the family member or guardian.

Students who leave the campus without permission and without being signed out by their parent, guardian, or designated representative will be counted truant and treated according to the Student Code of Conduct. Students who do not return to school on-time to their next class will be counted as tardy and be treated according to the Student Code of Conduct.
